**Structure and contents**

Agenda 21 is a 300-page document divided into 40 chapters that have been grouped into 4 sections:

- *Section I: Social and Economic Dimensions* is directed toward combating poverty, especially in [developing countries](#), (2/3 UN are third-world) changing consumption patterns, promoting health, achieving a more sustainable population, and sustainable settlement in [decision making](#).
- *Section II: Conservation and Management of Resources for Development* Includes atmospheric protection, combating [deforestation](#), protecting fragile

- environments, conservation of biological diversity ([biodiversity](#)), [control of pollution](#) and the management of [biotechnology](#), and [radioactive wastes](#).
- *Section III: Strengthening the Role of Major Groups* includes the roles of [children](#) and youth, [women](#), [NGOs](#), [local authorities](#), business and industry, and workers; and strengthening the role of [indigenous peoples](#), their communities, and [farmers](#).
  - *Section IV: Means of Implementation: implementation* includes [science](#), [technology transfer](#), [education](#), [international institutions](#) and financial mechanisms.

Major Goals:

1. Promote global warming theory
2. Transfer wealth from developed nations to third world nations (2/3 of UN)
3. Control education and child care

7. Replace freedom and individualism with communitarianism

**Strategy: End run around national and State governments to locals - voluntary**

## Methods of Implementation:

- **One of the ways is by using the Delphi Technique (The Delphi Technique is a way to obtain the opinion of experts without necessarily bringing them together face to face) to 'manufacture consensus.' Another is to**
- **Infiltrate community groups or actually start neighborhood associations with handpicked 'leaders'. ACORN - The Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now – name changes, several groups**
- **Recruit, groom and train future candidates for local offices.**
- **Sponsor non-governmental groups that go into schools and train children.**
- **Offer federal and private grants and funding for city programs that further the agenda.**
- **Educate a new generation of land use planners to require New Urbanism.**
- **Convert factories to other uses, introduce energy measures that penalize some resource usages and manufacturing, and set energy consumption goals to pre-1985 levels. Another is to**
- **Allow unregulated immigration in order to lower standards of living and drain local resources.**

## Obama Signs Agenda 21-Related Executive Order

President Obama signed his [86th executive order](#) (13575) on June 9, which established the White House Rural Council (WHRC). According to *The Blaze*, the Executive Order seems to be in line with the United Nations radical [Agenda 21](#), as it is designed “to begin taking control over almost all aspects of the lives of 16 percent of the American people.” Evidence of this can be found in Section One of the Executive Order, which [reads](#):

Section 1. Policy. Sixteen percent of the American population lives in rural counties. Strong, sustainable rural communities are essential to winning the future and ensuring American competitiveness in the years ahead. These communities supply our food, fiber, and energy, safeguard our natural resources, and are essential in the development of science and innovation. Though rural communities face numerous challenges, they also present enormous economic potential. The Federal Government has an important role to play in order to expand access to the capital necessary for economic growth, promote innovation, improve access to health care and education, and expand outdoor recreational activities on public lands.

## U.S. OPPOSITION

During the last 10 years or so, opposition to Agenda 21 has increased within the United States at the local, state, and federal levels. The Republican National Committee in 2012 election year adopted a resolution opposing Agenda 21, and the Republican Party platform stated, “We strongly reject the U.N. Agenda 21 as erosive of American sovereignty.” Several state and local governments have considered or passed motions, resolutions and legislation opposing Agenda 21. Alabama became the first state to prohibit government participation in Agenda 21. Many other states, including Arizona, are drafting, and close to passing legislation to ban Agenda 21.

### **National Republican Committee wording on Resolution Opposing Agenda 21**

WHEREAS, the United Nations Agenda 21 is being covertly pushed into local communities throughout the United States of America through the International Council of Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) through local “sustainable development” policies such as Smart Growth, Wildlands Project, Resilient Cities, Regional Visioning Projects, and other “Green” or “Alternative” projects; and,

WHEREAS, according to the United Nations Agenda 21 policy, social justice is described as the right and opportunity of all people to benefit equally from the resources afforded us by society and the environment which would be accomplished by socialist/communist redistribution of wealth; and,

WHEREAS, according to the United Nations Agenda 21 policy National sovereignty is deemed a social injustice; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, the Republican National Committee recognizes the destructive and insidious nature of United Nations Agenda 21 and hereby exposes to the public and public policy makers the dangerous intent of the plan; and therefore be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the U.S. government and no state or local government is legally bound by the United Nations Agenda 21 treaty in that it has never been endorsed by the (U.S.) Senate, and therefore be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the federal and state and local governments across the country be well informed of the underlying harmful implications of implementation of United Nations Agenda 21 destructive strategies for “sustainable development” and we hereby endorse rejection of its radical policies and rejection of any grant monies attached to it, and therefore be it further

**RESOLVED**, that upon the approval of this resolution the Republican National Committee shall deliver a copy of this resolution to each of the Republican members of Congress, all Republican candidates for Congress, all Republican candidates for President who qualify for RNC sanctioned debates, and to each Republican state and territorial party office and recommend for adoption into the Republican Party Platform at the 2012 Convention.
